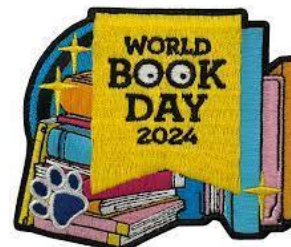

Dolce

We have been informed by Dolce that there will be a price increase from the **1st April** for school lunches.

Nursery children's lunches are currently £2.28 and will increase to £2.50
