Fr Mark has asked us to share the following information:

There will be <u>ONE</u> meeting for the parents of the children wishing to celebrate these Sacraments next year. The meeting will be **MONDAY 30<sup>th</sup> September at 7-8pm** in the Parish Hall. This will be the **only** opportunity to register and

complete the applications forms. Parents will need proof of baptism if the child has not been baptised in St. John's. Those wishing to celebrate Confirmation must have already celebrated First Confession and First Holy Communion. Those wishing to celebrate First Holy Communion in Y4 must have already celebrated First Confession. If they have not they may prepare for and celebrate First Confession this year and then Holy Communion the following year. There is to be a year between the celebration for First Confession and First Holy Communion. ALL THOSE WISHING TO CELEBRATE THESE SACRAMENTS, LIKE ALL CATHOLICS, MUST BE ATTENDING MASS EACH WEEK AND HOLY DAY.
